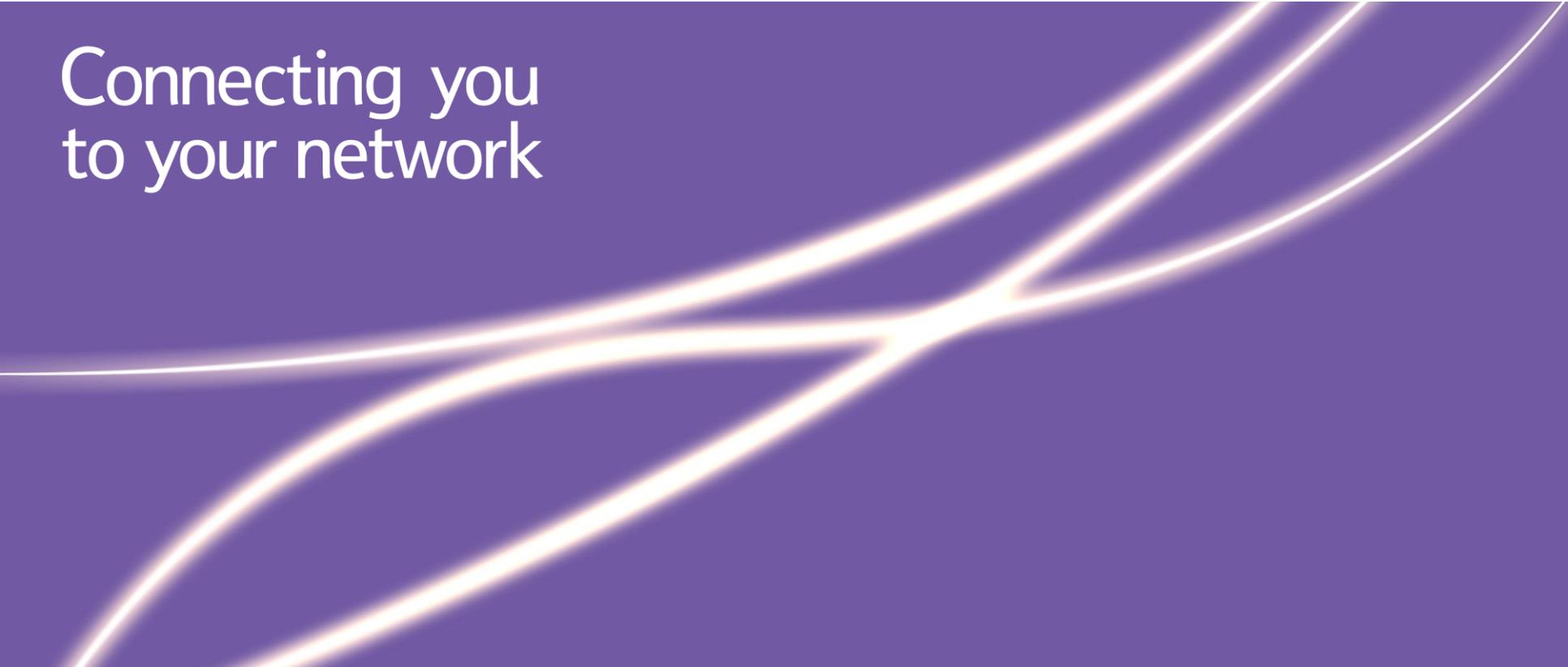


## UK Gigabit Broadband Voucher Scheme

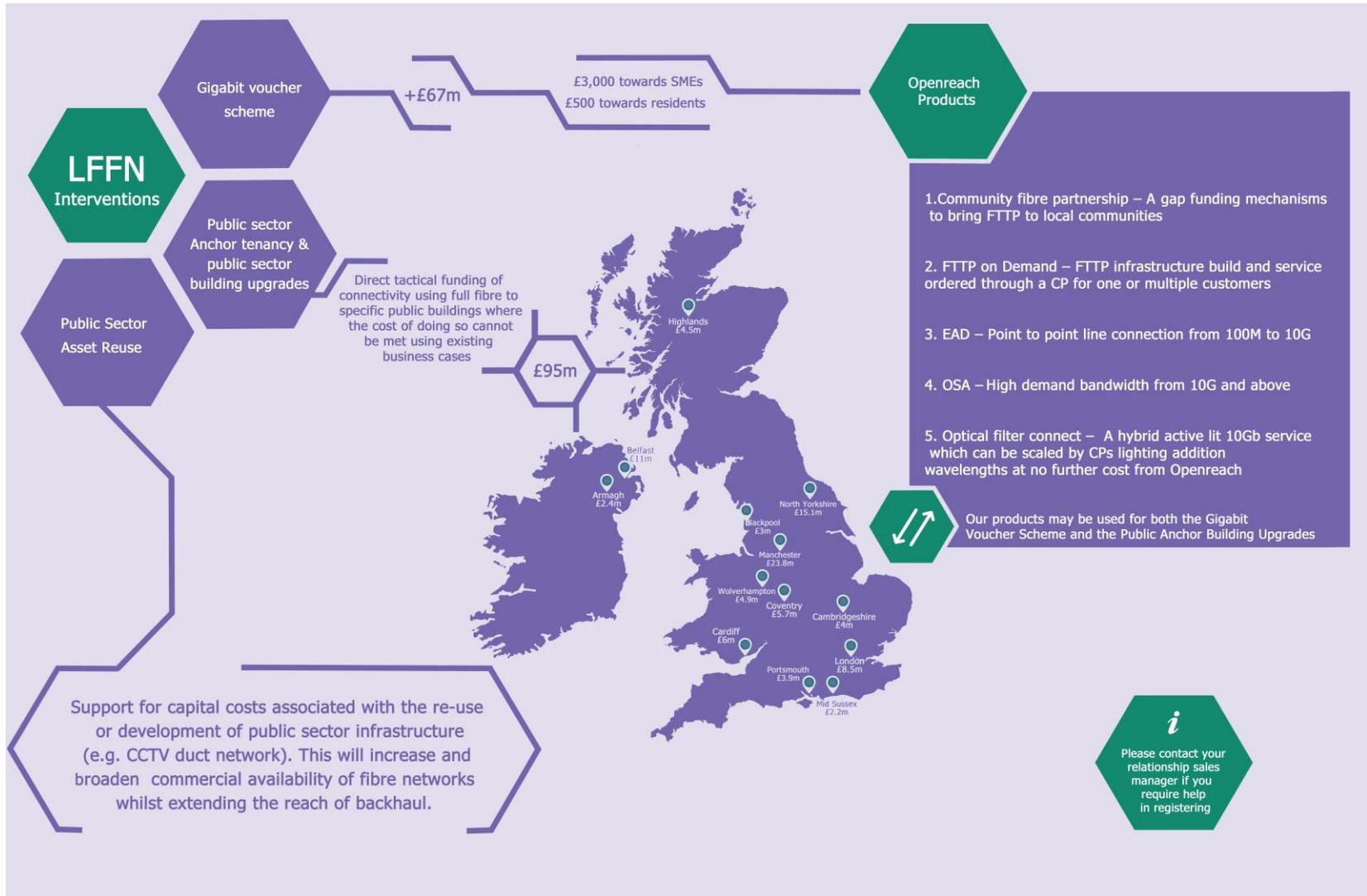

## What is it?

- The Department of Digital, Culture, Media & Sport (DCMS) is introducing a [Gigabit Broadband Voucher Scheme](#) for small and medium-sized businesses (SMEs), which is part of the [Local Full Fibre Networks \(LFFN\) Programme](#) is now available **UK WIDE!**
- The purpose of the Scheme is to increase the number of Gigabit capable connections within the UK by providing micro-grants to SMEs, to be spent on the installation charges for new connectivity. Businesses will not be required to subscribe to Gigabit services, but the connections must be capable of supporting these speeds (up OR down) within 10 days
- This scheme is one of four initiatives that have been allocated £200m by Government until 2020
- Vouchers will range from £500 to £3000 per SME, with the possibility to aggregate vouchers subject to DCMS validation
- Residential voucher schemes will be worth up to £500
- The Scheme is open for applications and will remain open until March 2019 or until the £2 million fund the DCMS have set up for the test phase has been allocated – whichever is sooner

# Background information on the vouchers and products available from Openreach

- Vouchers can be redeemed for up to 100% of the connection charge (including any ECC charges) for products that have been pre-approved by DCMS
- The Voucher will pay towards part or all of the fixed costs of getting you connected - between £500 and £3,000 – you pay the ongoing line rental charge and VAT.
- SMEs should read the full [terms and conditions](#) before accepting.

## Who is eligible?

- SMEs with up to 249 employees and with a turnover no greater than €50m per annum, and/or balance sheet of less than €43m.
- The scheme covers products that deliver at least 100Mbps, upgradable to 1Gbps.
- Vouchers are to cover the cost of connecting SMEs to existing or new Gigabit capable infrastructure (to a maximum of £3000).
- The key criteria is that upgraded broadband service must deliver a “step change” in the SME’s connectivity, which is at least a doubling of speeds compared to the service currently being consumed by the SME.
